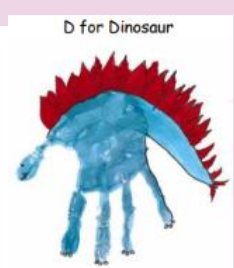
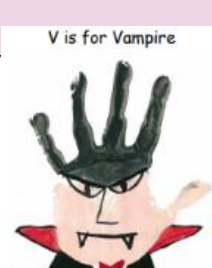

	P7 Social Enterprise Homework Challenge As part of our Social Enterprise learning, pupils will design a product that could be sold at a school fundraiser and create a simple "Dragons' Den" style pitch. What your child needs to do: • Think of a product that could be sold to raise money for your leavers hoodies. • Explain who would buy it and why. • Work out: ○ How much it would cost to make one item. ○ How much it could be sold for. ○ How much profit could be made. • Present their idea on paper or digitally. Example: • Cost to make a bookmark: £0.50 • Selling price: £2.00 • Profit per bookmark: £1.50	You can add a photo/drawing, and video of your idea to the SHOWBIE Assignment. If you want, you could also think about how you can persuade others to take onboard your idea. Remember we learned about making a 'sales pitch' at the end of P6 when we designed our theme parks in math's.
