This term we will be learning about ...



Literacy

- Reading: P2/3 will read a variety of stories to develop our understanding of character and setting, as well as techniques like alliteration and rhyme.
- **Writing**: P2/3 are learning to annotate diagrams and create information reports linked to our topics
- Listening & Talking: Primary 2/3 are thinking about communicating using tone, volume and body language, as well as giving opinions.

Expressive Arts (Including Dance)

- Drama: Primary 2/3 will use drama to explore emotions, linking this to familiar characters as well as our own feelings.
- Art: P2/3 will use collaging skills and familiar shapes as well as learn about using secondary colours to create recognizable images.
- Music: P2/3 will explore songs and rhythms to support our language learning. We will also giving our opinions on a variety of songs and music.

Technologies

 This term P2/3 will be revisiting how to use the netbooks successfully including logging in, accessing and using search engines, and using word to present text and images.

Numeracy & Mathematics

- Maths: P2/3 will build upon their knowledge of 2D shape and expand their understanding of different 3D shapes.
- Numeracy: Primary 2/3 are learning to recognize, write, read and build numbers. We will explore strategies to add and multiple numbers, and increase our understanding of our times tables.

Social Subjects and Sciences

- •Plants: P2/3 will be exploring the parts of the plant, the roles they play and what a plant needs to survive. We will create an experiment to test our ideas.
- •Our Body: Primary 2/3 will learn more about our bodies. We will learn about the role of the skeleton and major organs as well as about germs and keeping healthy.

Outdoor Learning

 We will attend the garden to maintain our bed, plant new crops and take part in Scotland the Bread.

Homework

All children will receive a reading book home on a weekly basis. Homework is sent home on Wednesdays and should be returned the following Monday.

Health & Wellbeing (Including PE)

- •**Health and Wellbeing**: Primary 2/3 are thinking about communicating and collaborating through play, and discussing emotions through Emotion Works.
- **PE**: This term Primary 2/3 will work on their fitness and stamina as well as exploring movement and body control in Gymnastics.

PE Days: Tuesday and Thursday

R.M.E.

Primary 2/3 are exploring the theme of Caring and Sharing through our discussions on children rights, exploration of emotions and the creation of a class charter. We will consider the values we hold and how sharing experiences and thoughts can bond people.

Languages

Primary 2/3 will cover the French and BSL for the days of the week, month of the year, the seasons, colours and parts of their body.
