- **Houses:** P7 House Captains have recently visited another school and are consulting with other children on how we move forward.
- We are looking at families and children's views/ideas etc about homework and hoping to have a draft Homework Policy in place by beginning of T4. We will be needing a parent/carer group to share their thoughts before sharing more widely.
- Upcoming dates for this term were shared in January newsletter – children attending dance festivals, the Fife Festival of Music and sporting events.
- **School trips:** All classes will be going on a trip before the end of session.
