Term 4 updates

- Upcoming dates for this term were shared in Week 1 newsletter – children are attending sports events, school trips and transition days/sessions etc.
- In collaboration with the CLP nature Action group the whole school will be attending the 'Beach of Dreams' event on Monday 19th May.
- A few children from each class are collating feedback from their classes on items our children would prefer for the play park.
- Transforming Learning: All P6 and P7 children will be receiving an iPad next session and all staff will be accessing professional learning on how to use digital technologies to enhance learning and teaching.
- HT post update – "Education Authority is looking at this and will provide further information over the next few weeks."

- As previously agreed, Parent Council will assist with the additional cost of our school trips after all children pay £10 each. Mrs Sloper also kindly requested help with the costs of buses to other events for our children which PC also agreed to pay.
- Reports will look slightly different this year due to Fife Council implementing a new system. Information will be shared with families about the new format when reports go out in June.
- Our Homework strategy will be shared this term and in place for next session.
- We will be having an art award for our P7s dedicated to Mrs Ollis as she always ensured our children produced fabulous art work through her passion for this subject. There are discussions happening with staff and children about other ways we can remember Mrs Ollis, particularly moving forward into a new school session.
- Davina will be retiring as janitor and 'Lollipop Lady' at the end of this term, however, our children will still see her as she will be continuing to serve lunches each day.
- Our P4-P7s will be presenting 'Wicked' this year for their show...and we are all super excited about this!
