1. <u>Upcoming events</u> — Movie Nights unlikely to go ahead due to lack of alternative dates this term and due to strike disruption.

The Summer Fayre's proposed date is 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

There is potential for a sponsored event as a school fundraiser. We are open to ideas on this, last year we did the Danceathon.

2. **Decant update** — a SWAY has been shared with families. The feedback from the parent council group was that the information was clear to understand. The SWAY was also shared with children at assembly.

The proposed bus route was discussed and the position of bus bays. Crossing patrol will be on duty before and after school. Entry routes and stairwells were pointed out on the map for clarity.

Development at St Kenneth's is starting now, including upgrading wifi. The modular units are due to be installed during the Easter Holidays.
