Interdisciplinary Learning

Topic - Our topic this term is The Alien has Landed where we will learn about our local community, what type of houses are in Markinch and what community groups are available. Outdoor Learning — We will be walking around the community as part of the topic but we will also be taking part in activities which help to develop our listening and communication skills.

Class Charter – We have created a Class Charter, showing our understanding of the UNCRC Rights of the Child. We will be linking lessons to different rights throughout the year.

School Values- We are continuing to focus on our new school values (Motivating our pupils to be ambitious, respectful and kind) and doing this in and around school.
