## Opportunities for personal achievement

## Interdisciplinary Learning

**Mr Men and Little Miss** – since we started P2/3, we have been focusing on Mr Men and Little Miss books and have been carrying out activities with this theme to help us settle into our new class and get to know one another.

**Topic** – We will be moving on to the topic of The Zoo. We are going to be Zoo Keepers and will be helping Edinburgh Zoo with information about the animals at their zoo looking at habitats and general information about the animals.

**Outdoor Learning** – Children will have opportunities to work on their communication and leadership skills throughout our teambuilding activities outdoors and at outdoor gym.

**Literacy** – we will spend this term following Big Writing lessons which will improve our VCOP and sentence structure. We will continue to learn from the Letters and Sounds scheme to help with our phonics and reading.

**Numeracy** – we will look at revising number and extending this to learn about larger numbers and their place value. We will also cover the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

**HWB** – in gym we will be using small equipment to play games and start gymnastics. We will need to use coordination, team work and listening skills. Through MR Men books, we will be learning about our emotions and how to manage them.

**ICT** – we will be learning how to log in to a laptop independently and accessing a variety of applications and websites.
