#### Hyperbole (exaggeration)

> She'd said that a million times.

### Simile (uses 'like' or 'as')

- > The rain was like a hail of bullets.
- > He ran as fast as a cheetah.

### Metaphor

- > My hands were icicles in the cold weather.
- ➢ He was a man mountain.
- She was a night owl.

### Personification (gives something human characteristics or actions)

- > The grains of sand danced across the beach.
- > The sun kissed my cheeks.
- > The wind howled.

### Adjectives/Adverbs (describing words)

> Carelessly he trampled through the long, damp grass.

### Power of 3 (3 adjectives, adverbs or verbs in row)

> The seaweed lay at my feet – smelly, wet and green.

#### Onomatopoeia (word sounds like the noise)

- ➢ BANG!
- > SPLASH!
- ➢ WOOF!
- ➢ BUZZ!

# Repetition

> He was worried, very worried indeed.

# Alliteration (repetition of first sound)

> The boy buzzed around as busy as a bee.
