

# Milesmark Primary School Term 4 April to June Learning Overview for Primary 4/5/6

### Literacy

#### WRITING:

This term we will be focusing on writing to convey information. This will include describing events, explaining processes and combining events. We will explore this in relation to our class topic Dunfermline/ Malcolm and Margaret.

## **SPELLING & PHONICS:**

Following on from last term we will be working on different spelling rules and patterns that have been identified for practise. We will be working hard on learning our spelling rules and then using the spelling rules in other areas of our work.

## **READING:**

Our class novel is The Escape Room by Christopher Edge. We will be reading this in class, and it will be used for comprehension lessons looking at developing their skills in predicting, summarising, and inferring.

Students will continue in their reading groups focusing on their assigned book. Books will be used for homework to develop independent reading skills.

# LISTENING & TALKING:

This term we will be developing and building on our presentation skills. Students will be tasked create a small presentation (using information from reliable sources) and will present it to a small audience.

### **Numeracy and Mathematics**

#### **NUMERACY:**

We have a focus on mental maths this term so we will be looking at strategies that help develop these skills independently i.e. splitting numbers up, rounding, flipping the question or counting on/backwards. We will also be looking at increasing our times tables recall.

### **MATHEMATICS:**

This term we will be building our knowledge of decimals, fractions and percentages. We will be focused on showing the relationship between them as well as looking at equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions, finding a fraction of an amount and percentages of amounts. We will also be looking at measurement and data handling in the coming weeks.

## **Health and Wellbeing**

### P.E

This term we will be developing a range of skills through athletics. This will include activities that test agility, balance, coordination, reaction times and speed.

## Health:

This term we will have a focus on RSHP where each primary will be working through the relevant progression. We will also be looking at physical wellbeing by developing our knowledge of the human body to improve wellbeing and health.

## Topic

P4/5/6 will be exploring the topic of Dunfermline / Margaret and Malcolm this term. We will be looking at who Margaret and Malcom were and who they were to Scotland. We will also look at their connection to Dunfermline Abbey and its history.

# Languages/RME

We will be continuing on from Mrs Lobban and recapping previous French Vocabulary. We will also be looking at developing our own beliefs and how they relate to other world religions.
