Modern Languages (French)

In Modern Languages we intend to ...

- consolidate colours, numbers to 20 and days of the week.
- consolidate vocabulary for pets and food.
- talk about the vocabulary for body parts.
- P3s will consolidate prior learning and respond to simple classroom instructions.

Numeracy and Mathematics

In Numeracy and Mathematics we intend to ... (Working at our own level)

- explore numbers to 100 (P2s), 1000 (P3s).
- count forwards and backwards up to 100/1000.
- estimate an amount and count to check.
- P2s will examine 3D and 2D shapes. P3s will identify prisms and pyramids.
- use language of probability.
- P2s use language such as 'won't happen' 'will happen' 'always' 'never' 'sometimes'
- identify situations which would be fair
- P3s will explore the difference between impossible and unlikely and certain and likely

In Literacy and English we intend to ...
