

All at our own level <ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn to write instructions, a poem and imaginative descriptions. continue to learn how to spell common words. talk about our likes and dislikes of different books and authors. respond to questions about fiction and non-fiction texts. practise the formations for numbers and letters. P2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn about vowels and consonants, using word banks and when to use question marks and exclamation marks. learn spellings for final double sounds (ss,zz,ff.ll) P3 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> learn long vowel spellings and alternative sounds. learn to use more complex connectives and when to use a/an. They will also consolidate using question marks, exclamation marks and other punctuation within their writing.
