### Rainbow Room and Sunflower Room

We are very happy to share with you the news that after the Easter break our children in the Rainbow Room and Sunflower room will be attending nursery between the hours of 9-3! Some of our children will be fine attending from 9-3 but some children and families may prefer reduced hours. Please speak to your child's key worker about times that will suit your child.

As I'm sure you can imagine there has been a lot of planning and preparation behind the scenes and I'm sure you will all have a lot of questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's key worker.

Your child will be provided with a packed lunch and a cup of home made soup, free of charge every day. We will soon be asking you to chose your child's roll filling for their packed lunch, you will be asked to make 2 weeks worth of choices at a time.

If you would rather provide your child with their own packed lunch then this must be supplied in a wipeable box to enable us to sanitise the box when your child brings it into nursery. Your child will go to lunch with staff from their room and remain in their bubble.

### Nursery Contribution

Due to the increase in the amount of hours at nursery, each child will receive a morning snack and an afternoon snack, we will also be using more resources etc. Due to this our nursery contribution will increase to £2.50 per week. If you have two children at the nursery you only need to make one payment per week.

### See saw

Please remember to check your child's see saw account on a regular basis. Any learning that you share on see saw will go into your child's plj.

### Rainbow Room

Due to Covid guidelines stating that we can only have a maximum of 33 children in each bubble we have had to split the Rainbow room into two groups that will begin after the Easter holidays. They will be the orange and red group. We have tried to maintain friendship groups and session groups as much as possible. Your child's key worker will let you know what group your child will be in and what entrance you should use with your child at pick up and drop off.
