



## **Pitreavie Primary School** **Standards and Quality Report 2024-2025**

### **About Our School**

Pitreavie Primary is located in Dunfermline and serves 405 children across mainstream, nursery, and additional support classes. The school promotes values of Ambition, Kindness, Respect, and Responsibility, with a vision to 'Play Together, Learn Together, Achieve Together'.

Visitors always comment on the high level of respect and manners that the children show to adults and each other.

### **Attendance & Wellbeing**

Attendance is good with an average of 93%. The school supports families by offering a breakfast club, two nurture spaces, pre-loved uniforms, free hygiene products, and help with trip costs.

### **Listening to You**

Parents, pupils, and partners were consulted through questionnaires, focus groups, pupil committees and parent council meetings to shape school improvements.

### **Key Improvements This Year**

1. Pupil Voice & Rights Education – Children learned about their rights and how they relate to learning. Rights are now part of daily classroom life.
2. Teaching & Learning – Teachers improved feedback and planning. Children are more aware of their progress and next steps.
3. Family Engagement – Seesaw blogs, coffee mornings, and learning events helped parents stay connected and informed.

## Attainment

Most children in P1 and P4 met or exceeded expectations in literacy and numeracy. P7 showed good progress despite a slight dip Whilst there was a higher-than-average level of additional support in P7: we have recognised that and put additional planning into place.
