How we will communicate with you

Key dates and school events

There will be a termly overview of events sent out at the beginning of the term with key dates and school events. This will be available on the Headteacher SWAY and Seesaw.

There will be times when dates may change or are yet to be confirmed. We will ensure that this is communicated as soon as possible.

Headteacher's SWAY

There will be a weekly update about the life and work of the school from the Headteacher sent via email (SWAY). This will also include key dates and upcoming school and community events.

Communication about Learning

We use the Seesaw app to share learning experiences and events specific to each class and child during the school week. The information in the app will help you understand your child's learning experiences and provide opportunities for discussion at home.

We will post upcoming dates for events and outdoor learning. Each week you will also get

- A message from the class teacher with learning focus for the week in literacy, numeracy and one other area of the curriculum
- 2 posts about their learning

- Speak to your child about what they have been learning
- Check for updates from the class teacher
- Let us know if you can help with Outdoor Learning/Trips and Activities. If you have volunteered to help and can no longer do this, please contact the school office.

You may also be able to speak to the Headteacher or Principal Teacher at the school gates or via the office.

If staff are not available immediately, they will be in contact with you as soon as possible.
