Attainment Fund Rationale: Raise engagement in Learning

Through targeted use of our Pupil Equity Fund, Pittencrieff Primary aims to ensure **every child is supported, included, and ready to learn**, regardless of their background or circumstances. We have identified

Expected Impact

Improved emotional regulation, resilience, and readiness to learn. Stronger relationships and engagement across the school.

Increased time in class, reduced dysregulation, and improved focus for pupils accessing the Hub.

Every child starts the day nourished, calm, and ready to learn. Improved focus and behaviour in morning lessons.

Interventions Planned

Employ a **School Counsellor/Art Therapist** (1 day per week) to support pupils struggling with emotional regulation and wellbeing. Staff will also receive training.

Create and staff a **Learning Hub** – a calm, nurturing space for targeted support, co-regulation, and re-engagement in learning.

Provide **toast and fruit** in class for all pupils at the start of the day.

Measure of Success

Allocation: £31, 054

Tracking of attendance, time out of class, SHANARRI wellbeing data, staff and pupil feedback.

Staff observations; pupil feedback; monitoring of attendance, punctuality, and engagement.

Improved pupil wellbeing, behaviour, and engagement across the school.

Positive feedback from pupils, parents, and staff.

Clear evidence from attendance, and learning data showing greater inclusion and equity.
