Through our self-evaluation we have identified 3 key priorities for improvement 2023-2026:

- 1. Play phase 2; Schemas and possible lines of development; Developing curriculum 'maps' for BGE activities based on the needs and interests of the learners.
- 2. Positive destinations phase 2; Pathways to likely destinations including DYW activities
- 3. Tracking Piloting the new Progress tool for complex needs in Fife



We will develop our pupil interest based approaches throughout the BGE creating 'maps' to evidence coverage of the curriculum and focus on the milestones.

Develop understanding of schemas and possible lines of development to plan for provocations within play to enhance our child-led approaches.

Focus Priority 2 – Tracking

Use complex needs milestones and benchmarks for all curriculum areas to measure progress and achievement across the BGE using a range of assessment evidence to inform professional judgement.
