Formal Policies

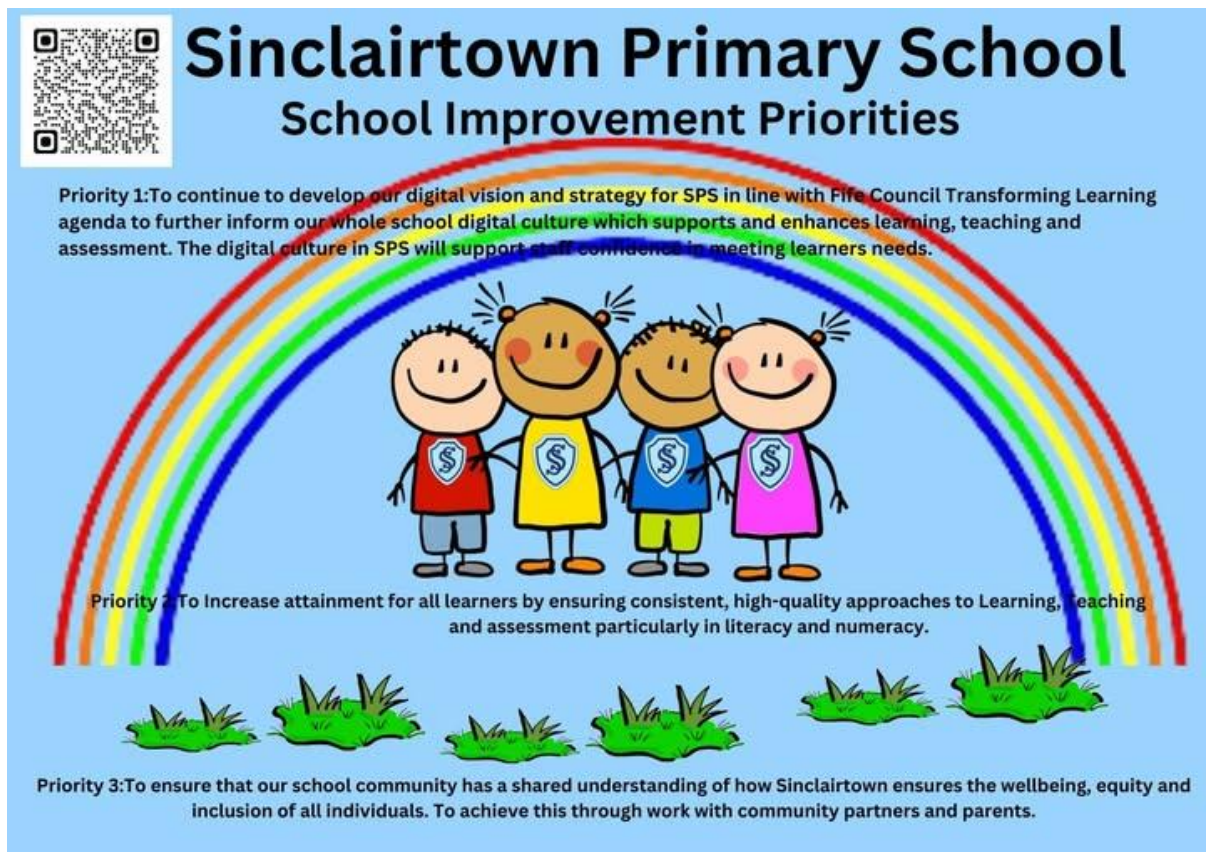
MG has drafted the Parent Council Formal Policies
