Can you find the capital letters and full stops? (We need a capital letter at the start of a new sentence.)</p>	<p><b>Writing:</b> Record your weekly news. Draw a picture to talk about. Tell your adult what the picture is about. Who is in your picture?</p> <p>Practise your letters underneath your picture. Ask an adult to help you tap out a word. Try and write the word.</p>
