

Dear Parents/Carers.

In light of the current news and events around the school closure, we wanted to inform you of the plan we have for all pupils to access learning from home.

We will be using the Glow platform (https://glow.rmunify.com/) to communicate and share teaching resources and tasks with the pupils. Each class teacher will have set up their own method for how pupils can access and use Glow. This has already been relayed to all pupils over the past week.

Pupils were given a work from home yellow jotter where they can complete their daily tasks. The pupils were also given their login details for Glow.

Glow is an online platform where pupils can access information, resources and methods of communication with their peers and class teachers. Pupils have been adding apps on their personal Glow pages which will link with their learning and different areas of the curriculum. These are accessible at any time.

## **Steps for Accessing Glow**

Go to <a href="https://glow.rmunify.com">https://glow.rmunify.com</a> and enter login details.

You will see the child's launch pad where the apps are located.

## **Steps for Accessing Office 365 on Glow**

When accessing email, Word, Excel etc., go to Office 365 app and click on the relevant option.

## **Steps for Accessing Classroom Homepages on Glow**

On the left of the screen there are 4 options where you can access 'My Launch Pad' and the 'St Columba's R C Primary School' launchpad.

Click on the app for 'School Site'.

When in the app, you will see the school's home page. On the left, you can access your relevant class.

Communication from class teachers can be found here.

Please access Glow daily to keep up to date with any information and enhance your child's learning. Glow is the main platform for lessons, resources and tasks set by class teachers for your children and their continued education.
