- All children to come to school at 9am as usual to register and order lunches.
- Children should ideally wear something in their house colour : Morton – blue, Kinshaldy – yellow, Scotsraig – green. This could be a ribbon, bracelet or t-shirt...
- Please apply sunscreen before school and send children with a sun hat.
- The Parent Council will provide a bottle of water and fruit bag for each child. No other snacks will be brought to the football ground.
- No videoing of races please. Please be mindful that other children may be in any photographs you take, and they should not be shared on social media.
- We are aiming for all classes to arrive at the football ground for 9:30am. Please let Sherree know if you can help escorting classes to/from the ground and/or volunteer to help during events.
- Only volunteers will be allowed on the track area. All other parents and carers must remain behind the fenced area. Children must remain with their teacher and class at all times.
- P1-3 will return to school after the three P4-7 races.
- There will be a presentation of P5-7 endurance race medals at the end of the morning:
 - Girl/boy 1st/2nd/3rd in each category
 - Scott Mill Memorial Shield for overall fastest runner in endurance race.
- We anticipate p4-7 will return to school by 12:30 pm.
