This will be an opportunity for parents/carers to come into their child's classrooms to see what they have been learning during the Tayport Heritage Trail topic and other curricular areas. You can also look at and comment on your child's learning steps jotter in school, rather than it being sent home. For any families who cannot make it into school the learning step jotter will be sent home on the 20^{th} June and should be returned by Friday 24^{th} .

- Enter and leave the school via the main entrance.
- Mrs Tweed and Mrs Peterson will be there to welcome you and direct you to your child's class.

- Your child will share their learning steps jotter with you. Please add written feedback in this.
- Visitors are not expected to stay for the full hour we would suggest that 15 minutes should be enough time (per child).
- Your child must stay in their class, and you cannot take siblings from other classes to visit each other.
- All adults will leave the school building by 2:45 pm (3 short bells will be rung) which will then allow teachers to dismiss children at 3 pm.
