



28% of our families' opinions are represented in the responses below: *Gathered end of September 2024*

All parents/carers said:

-staff treat children fairly and with respect.

Almost all [90-99%] parent/carers said:

-they would recommend our school to other parents and that overall, they are satisfied with the school.

-their child likes being at our school.

-they felt comfortable approaching the school with questions, suggestions or problems.

-their child is safe at school.

- school helps their child feel confident.

- school knows their child as an individual.

Most [75-89%] parent/carers:

- said they are satisfied with the quality of teaching in our school

-know how to contact the parent council.

-said the school encourages children to treat others with respect.

-feel their child is encouraged to be healthy and take regular exercise.

The **majority [51-74%]** of parent/carers feel the school deals with bullying issues. The minority did not know if the school dealt with bullying.

Children's rights and how to be respectful to others will continue as explicit learning.

Our children have updated our anti-bullying policy. We will now share with families.
