Design a Sustainable House STEM Challenge



This term our whole school is celebrating the history of Tayport, as well as looking forward to its future. The STEM Challengers are looking to set a new design challenge...**If Tayport pupils could design sustainable homes for the future, what would they be like?**

The challenge begins on **Monday 28th April** and pupils will learn lots about it at our 'Learn to Learn' assembly on 30th April. We are encouraging pupils to draw plans and/or make simple 3D prototypes of their housing design (using recycled materials) that should answer these 8 questions...

1. **Can I build a house that encourages people to be healthy and happy?**
2. **Can I build a house that looks good and has good design?**
3. **Can I build a house that encourages flowers and plants to grow?**
4. **Can I build a house that encourages wildlife into a built-up community?**
5. **Can I build a house that collects rainwater?**
6. **Can I include reused and repurposed materials in the build?**
7. **Can I build a house with good insulation?**
8. **Can I build a house that is powered by renewable energy?**

The plans/models are due on **Wednesday 26th May** and will be evaluated by our STEM challenge MAD Group. We would then love to showcase these prototype models at our Learning Showcase on Friday 13th June.
