This term we will be learning about ...

Literacy and Languages:

French — Numbers to 10. Days of the week and Christmas.

Expressive Arts:

Music — Fischy music, Beatbox (Nativity) exploring sounds with voice and instruments. Art — Can share thoughts and feelings in response to an artists work. Explores light and dark.

Drama — Takes on the role of a character through storytelling and nativity performances.

Numeracy:

Time: Identifying o' clock, half past, quarter to/past.

Social Subjects:

Light and Dark; with links to day and night, nocturnal animals and firework night.

Sciences: Seasons; Autumn — Winter and links with day and night.

Exploring how water changes from one form to another.

Typing skills (Jungle junior and doorway online) Logging on to computer independently Accessing Glow Hardware / Software
