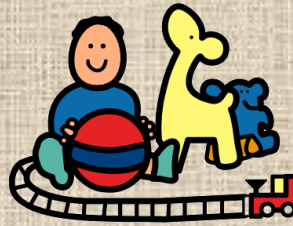


Growing and Learning Together

What does the curriculum look like at Torryburn?

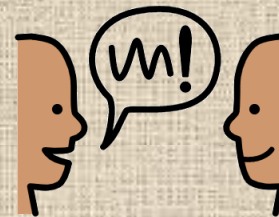
- Child led through children's voice
