


### Wonder

### Link Learning

This learning quality is all about making connections, making connections between learning at home and school or nursery, making connections in our play and between areas of learning. It is also about understanding the relevance of our learning in the present and in the future.

## Persevere

### Persevere

Persevere is all about setting ourselves a challenge and not giving up even when things are tricky. This is often linked to having a growth mindset. It also helps us understand that making mistakes are part of learning.

### Problem Solve

This learning word is about thinking deeply and trying different ways. As children mature they will become increasingly aware of the strategies which work best for them.

## Engage

Take responsibility for my learning.  
Be willing to learn.  
Be actively engaged in my learning.



### Engage

Engage is about being open to new learning and showing a willingness to learn. It is also about being actively involved and taking responsibility for our own learning. This means encouraging children to make decisions about their learning and play.

## Aim High!

Have high expectations for myself and others.  
Aspire to be the best I can.



### Aim High

This learning word is linked to one of our core values – aspiration. It is all about having high expectations for yourself and others. It's about trying to do more than you thought you could!

## Reflect and Adapt

Reflect on my learning and use feedback to help me learn.  
Plan on learning and how I will get there.



### Reflect and Adapt

Reflect and Adapt are all about knowing where you are in your learning, where you are going and how you will get there. Comparing our learning against success criteria and using feedback from others helps us achieve this.

## Learner Qualities

Our learning words or qualities were developed with staff, parents, children and partners. We use these words from the initial stages of nursery all the way through to the end of P7. These provide a shared language we can all use to talk about learning and the learning process. However, the words go beyond just a set of words to describe learning. By talking about what these words look like in action and by supporting children to identify when their actions exemplify these words we encourage children to develop the behaviours and habits described by these words. They help make learning visible!
