- We have worked with **more partners** this year to provide a wide range of experiences for our children
- In March, we achieved our **Silver Rights Respecting School** award
- The teacher’s planning calendar has been updated. It is now more clearly linked to:
 - Children’s rights
 - STEM
 - Sustainable and safe travel
- **Improvement floor books** have been introduced to capture evidence of the improvement work we are doing and the impact it is having for our children.
- There is **greater consistency** across the school in how often and what we teach for literacy.
