

## Wormit Primary School P4-7 Pupil Feedback March 2020

90 children completed the survey – this is 82% of the pupils in P4-7.

Almost everyone (96%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have known how to find my work on Teams

Most people (85%) agreed or mostly agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have understood what to do for my tasks. 14% said it was sometimes true.

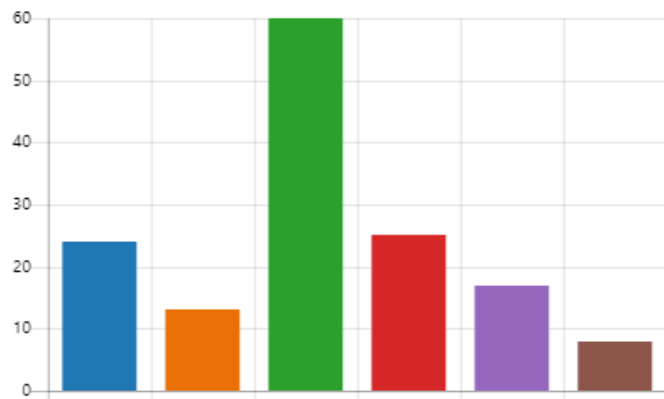
What ways has your teacher used to show you how to do your tasks:

● Videos she has made	31
● Videos other people have made	66
● Written explanations	64
● Video Calls	55
● Other	13



When I have been learning from home, I have asked my teacher for help by:

● Sending an email	24
● Asking my parents to email	13
● Writing in the chat on Teams	60
● Asking in a Video Meeting	25
● I haven't needed to ask for help	17
● Other	8



Most people (79%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have got help from my teacher when I asked for it. 20% told us they had never needed to ask for help.

Almost everyone (90%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have been able to keep in touch with others in my class.

Most people (74%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have had help from school when I needed it. The rest told us they had never needed help. No one replied that they'd wished they had help but didn't

People gave these examples of what has been good about learning from home:

- More time to play outside
- Having choice over when I do my work/going at my own pace
- Taking a break when I want
- Learning to work independently
- Having video calls
- Its quieter and that helps me concentrate
- Spending time with family
- Learning with my family

There were lots of different examples of what could have been better about learning from home and not all of them agree which is to be expected because different people have different views – for example, some people would like less work and some would like more. A lot of you have told us that you would have liked more contact with staff and friends and we understand that – you have all worked really hard in difficult times and we are looking forward to having you back at school.

People gave these examples of what they are looking forward to about coming back to school?

- Seeing friends
- Working with my teacher in person, being able to ask questions in person
- PE
- Art
- Spending less time on a computer
