How can we help?

The Listening Stone Programme

We offer a safe, therapeutic play space for children to learn, explore and process some of the hardships that they have experienced.

Through various art forms like dance, singing, music, drawing, painting and theater, children learn to express their emotions in new and creative ways. Additionally, they develop life skills like decision-making,

communication, self-awareness and problem solving. These abilities empower children to advocate for their progress on the path out of poverty.
