Summary for Families

In 2024-25, Our school improvement priorities were:

- Conceptual Understanding of Numeracy
- Pupils' Progress
- Relationships and Behaviour and Rights Respecting Ethos

What we did:

- All teaching staff took part in Conceptual Understanding of Numeracy Training
- All teaching staff became familiar with the new Progress System and used it to record tracking information and write end of year reports
- We finalised our Anti-Bullying Policy by capturing Parental Voice
- We worked together to share good practice and develop a Relationships and Behaviour Policy

What we need to do next:

- Audit maths resources to make sure all classes have access to the right materials to support their understanding of number
- Share the language of maths with our PSA team to develop their skills to support learning
- Develop a maths strategy to capture good practice and to ensure progression in learning in all areas of maths (Numeracy, Information Handling, Shape, Position and Movement)
- Audit our Health and Wellbeing planning tools to ensure we are evidencing pupils' progress
- Further develop practice to support children to discuss their learning and plan next steps
- Finalise the Relationships and Behaviour Policy through capturing Parental Voice
