LINKS TO NEWPORT ON TAY AND WORMIT PRIMARY SCHOOLS – PHASE 1

Fife Council Roads Transportation Services will shortly be undertaking footpath improvement and resurfacing works beginning January 12th 2026, with completion scheduled for late March 2026.

As part of these works, a new 2.5m wide active travel path will be installed, continuing from Wormit Primary School to Waterstone Crook Leisure Centre. This path aims to enhance connectivity from Flass Road to Waterstone Crook Leisure Centre, while also linking into the wider Active Travel Network linking Newport on Tay and Wormit Primary Schools. Together, these improvements will create a more extensive, accessible, and sustainable travel network that benefits local communities and encourages active travel choices.

Please note that the existing footpath will be closed for the duration of the works to ensure the safety of the public and the workforce. Signage and diversions will be in place to guide pedestrians to alternative routes, and we kindly ask for your cooperation during this period.

The works will be carried out by local contractor, T&N Gilmartin.

Potential disruptions may occur due to these works, but we will strive to minimise any inconvenience.
