#### Scots and Home Language Poems

Broomhill Primary School will shortly launch our annual Poetry Recital Showcase/Slam 2024. Traditionally the event has been aimed at encouraging children to explore and learn a range of Scots poems and songs. This year, following a consultation with the children, we are inviting children to learn a Scots poem or a poem in a language spoken at home. The children will select a poem to learn as home. The class teacher will inform pupils when they are expected to recite the poem in class.

Following the recitals in class, one representative from each of the sixteen classes will be nominated by their peers to enter a whole-school competition/slam, which will be held on World Poetry Day, **Thursday 21 March**, **1.30pm**. Families of class winners will receive an invite to the event.

To showcase the **29 languages spoken at home by families in Broomhill Primary**, our pupilled Equalities Group will create a new 'One School – Many Languages' display for our reception area. Each child who has a home language other than, or in addition to English, will be voice recorded, on a Qwiqr QR code, saying a message in their mother tongue. Those who speak English only at home will be invited to record inclusive messages about diversity. The QR codes will then be displayed for everyone to open and listen to.
