School Christmas Lunch

Christmas lunch will take place on **7 December 2023**.

Please note: standard and halal Christmas menus are attached to this correspondence. No other lunch options will be available on 7 December.

Because Broomhill Primary is having our Christmas lunch a week earlier than most schools (to coincide with Christmas Jumper Day), there will not be an option on ParentPay to select a 'Christmas' school lunch on 7 December.

Instead, every child who wishes a Christmas lunch on 7 December should complete their selection on the paper copy of the menu sent home on either 20 or 21 November.

Please discuss the Christmas menu with your child/children and return the completed options sheet to class teachers by Thursday 23 November. If your child is currently absent from school, please email the headteacher a completed copy of the relevant menu selection.

This information will then be passed on to the Catering Manager to allow sufficient time for food orders to be placed.

Meals for children in P1-5 are free. For children in P6-7, not entitled to free school meals, the cost is £1.90, via ParentPay

Christmas Jumper Swap Shop

In advance of Christmas Jumper Day (see details below) we are holding a Jumper Swap Shop. Families are invited to donate any unwanted Christmas jumpers for others to use over the festive period. This reduces the need to buy new jumpers, helping both to save money and the planet.
