Based on the results of our Family Learning consultation last session, we have planned a number of events to support you and to help you support your daughter's learning.

The first of these events takes place on **Thursday 19 September** and is aimed at parents of pupils in S4, S5 and S6 as they undertake their learning in National Qualifications and Higher. At our **Family Learning Evening** from **6.30 p.m. – 8.00 p.m.** you will have the opportunity to hear from departmental staff about the requirements of their course and how the girls can best prepare themselves for coursework tasks and examinations.
