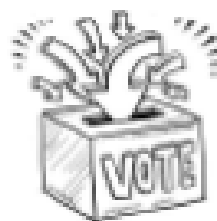

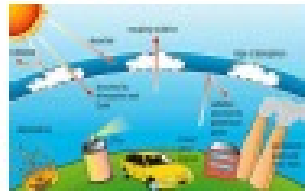

National 4 & 5 History

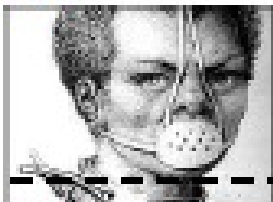
The topics you will be studying in S4 are:
