Attendance

Prior to the holidays, our attendance was at its lowest in all the years I have been at Anderston. However, I am very aware that we have had many children absent due to chicken pox, Strep A and there also seems to be a nasty sickness and flu type bug going around. This has obviously impacted on the children's learning but hopefully this term we can return to our normal attendance rate and children can get back on track





Latecoming

I am also aware that late coming is becoming an issue in the school. Children who arrive late are greatly disadvantaged because they miss starting the day with their peers and the beginning of lessons. This means that they are often unsettled and confused about tasks and their teacher will not always be able to re-explain work. It also causes a lot of congestion at the school office which is normally very busy at this time of the day.

We are introducing an initiative to encourage children to get to school on time - this is similar to our 'You've been spotted' programme. Classes are rewarded for having no latecomers and the class with the most cards will be rewarded at the end of term. This focus will hopefully instil good habits in the children as they go through school and move on to further education or the wider working world. We would appreciate your support with this.



Uniform



I am noticing a lot of children coming to school in brightly coloured jumpers and casual tracksuits. Again I continue to reiterate the importance of all children coming to school in uniform which consists of:

- White Shirt/Tie or White polo shirt with Anderston Logo
- Grey/Black skirt/trousers
- Navy jumper / cardigan with Anderston Logo

PLEASE ensure that your child's name is on **every** piece of clothing to ensure that if uniform does go missing, then it can be easily traced. Indoor shoes MUST be worn in school. Carpets in the classrooms are being ruined with children coming in with dirty shoes. Some of the children's indoor shoes are either becoming quite worn or are too small. Can you remind your child that if this is the case, then they bring them home and get them replaced? For the younger children, the class teacher will send the shoes home when this is the case.

School uniform can be ordered from the school office. Please contact Danielle who will give you a uniform order form. The parent council are also going to be setting up a pre-loved uniform shop and as soon as I have details of this, I will let you know.

Head Lice

I am continuing to highlight the issue of head lice and the need for everyone to work together to try to eradicate this problem.
