Library

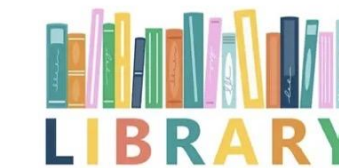


All classes will visit the library weekly or fortnightly.

Magma Maths

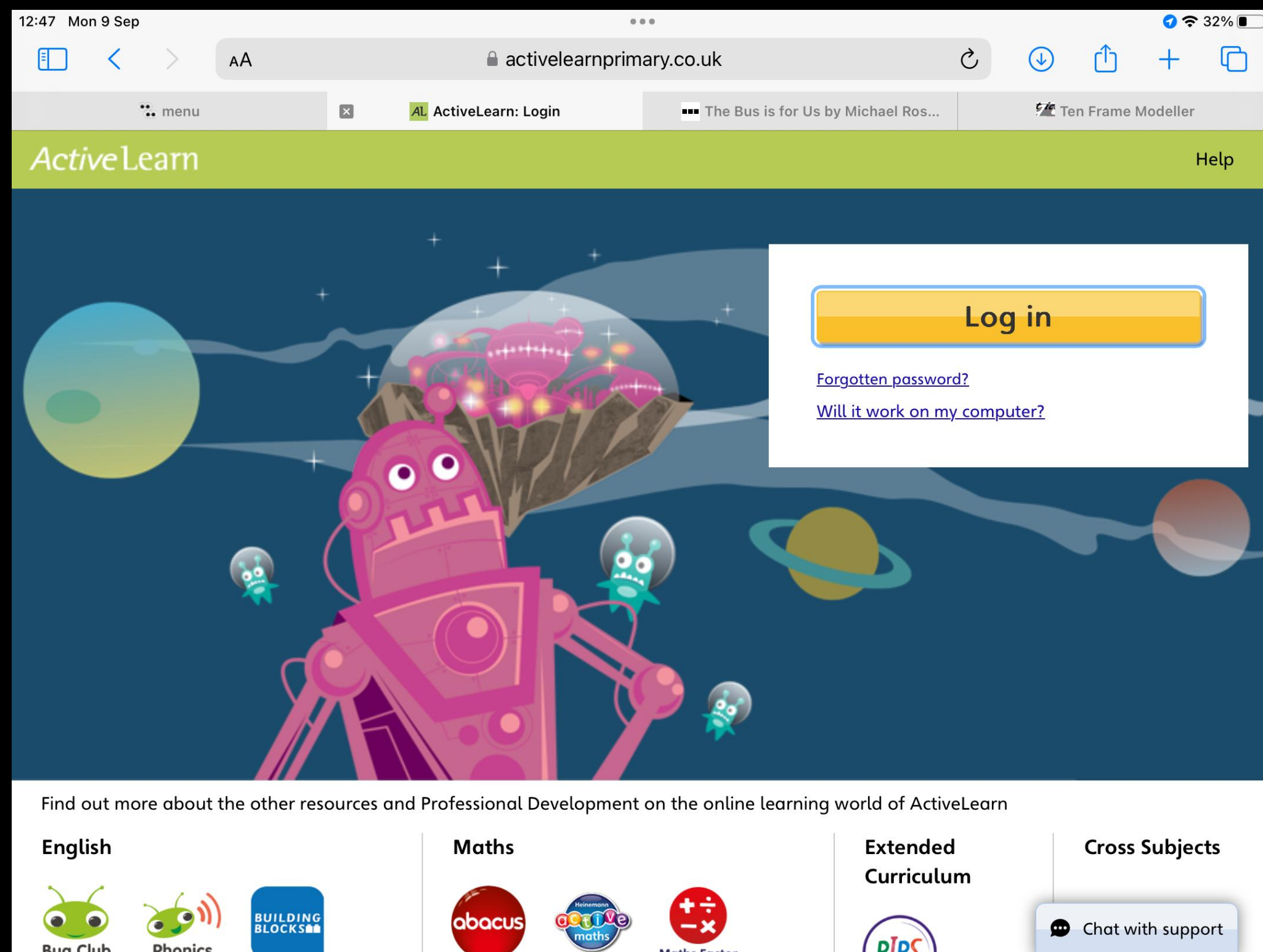


Magma Maths is new to Glasgow and we will be using it in class and at home. QR codes have been issued in homework folders along with guidance for logging in.
