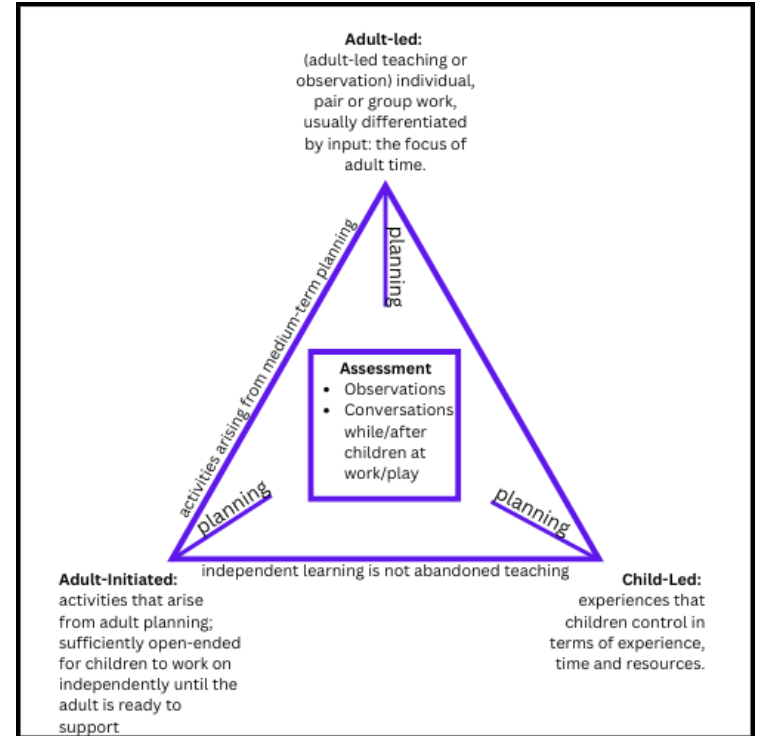

Play in P3

Play looks a little bit different to that in Primary 2.
