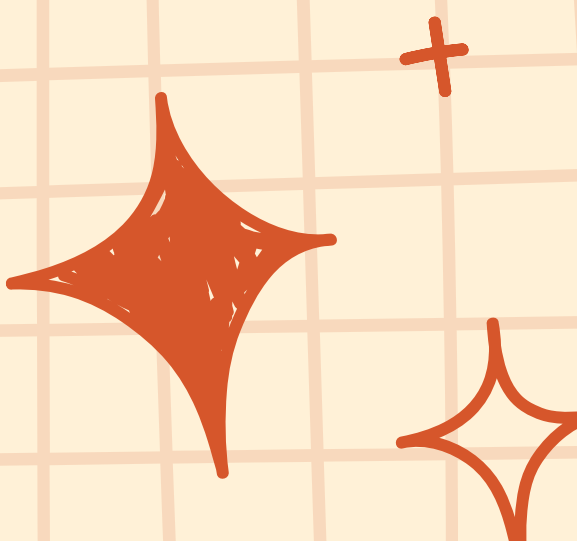
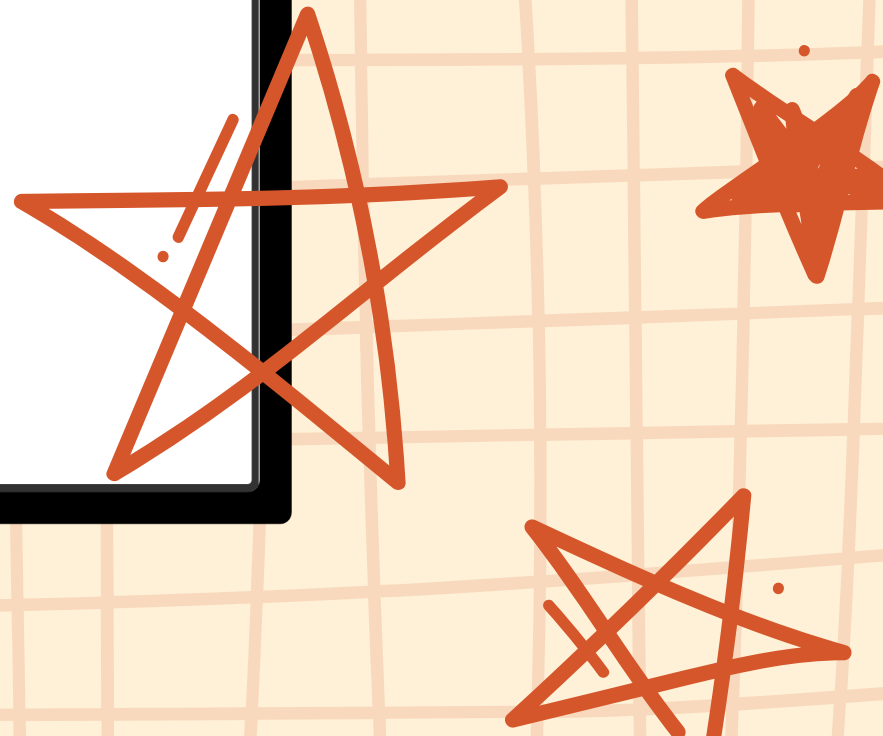

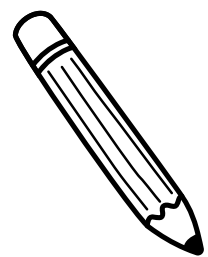


Information

Homework



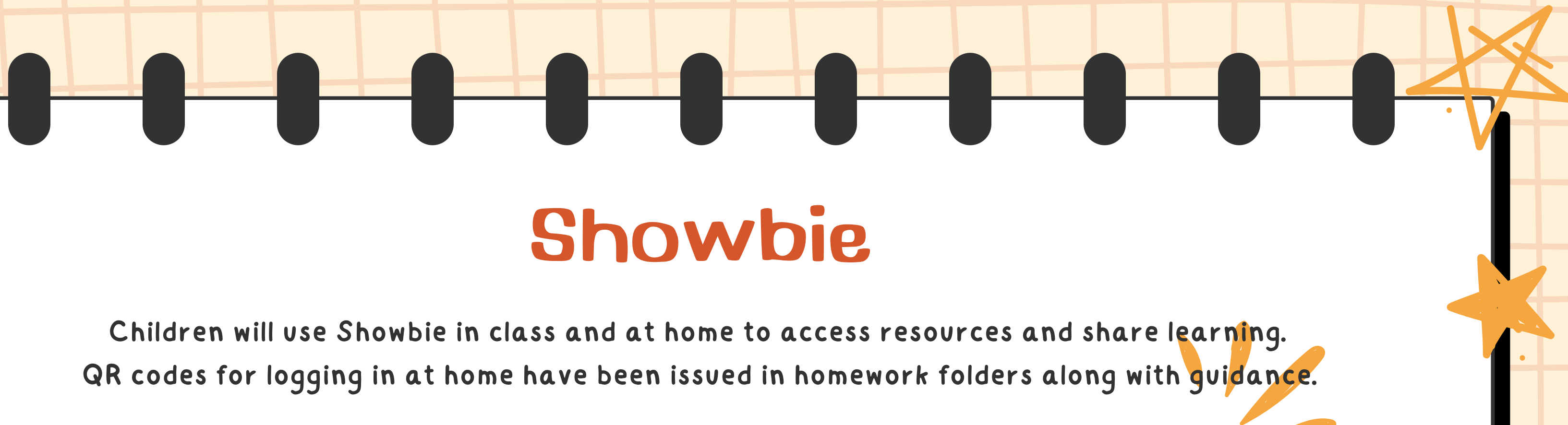
Please read your child's book with them every day. Your child will be able to practise reading comprehension skills on Bugclub Online. Your child should also have a school library book that you can enjoy together.

Please support your child to practise their spelling words and to write some sentences in their jotters using these words. We are having a focus on presentation in Primary 4. Please support your child to do their best handwriting in their homework jotter. You can also encourage your child to add some interesting vocabulary, adjectives and connectives into their sentences.

Your child will have a code for Magma Maths, where they can practise their maths skills. They should check the 'assignment' tab to see if I have given them a specific task.

Portfolios

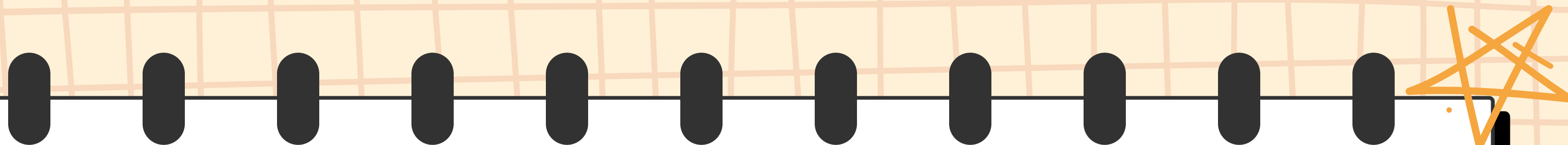
Staff/pupils will share one piece of work a fortnight to children's portfolios. Portfolios can be viewed on pupil or parent accounts.

Magma Maths

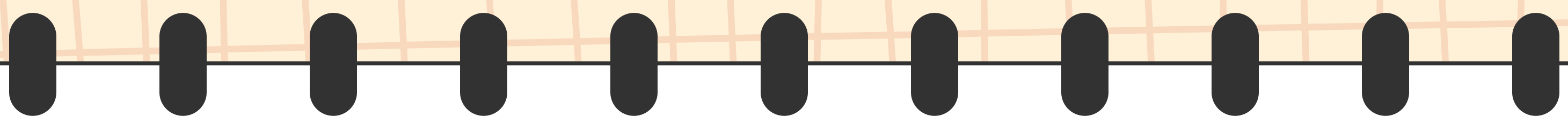
Magma Maths is new to Glasgow and we will be using it in class and at home. QR codes have been issued in homework folders along with guidance for logging in.



Magma is very user friendly; questions can be translated into many different languages.

It is important to note that for most questions children must show their working before it will allow them to input their answer. This encourages visible thinking.
