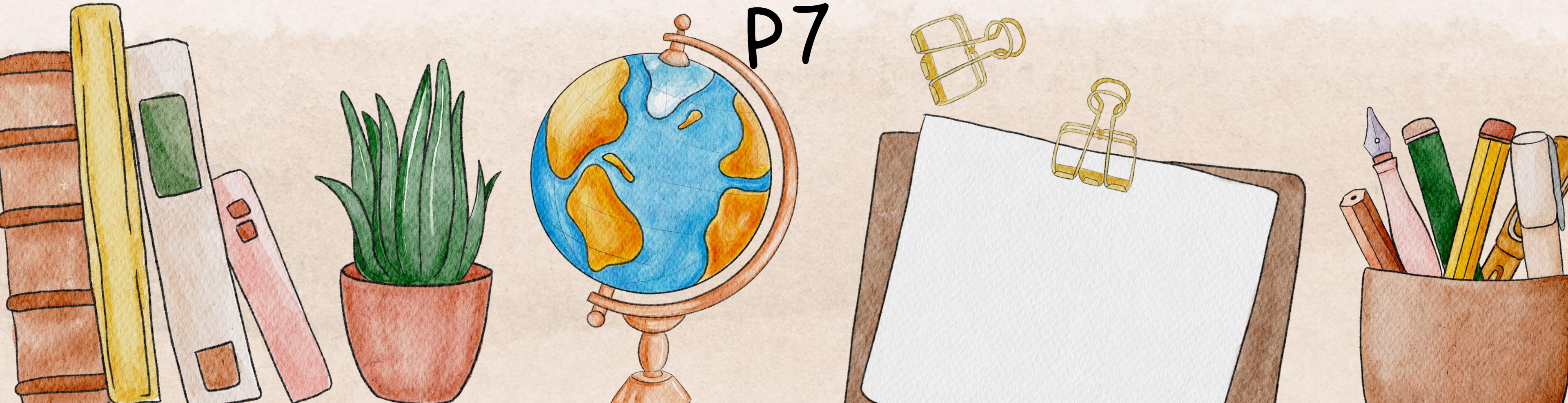

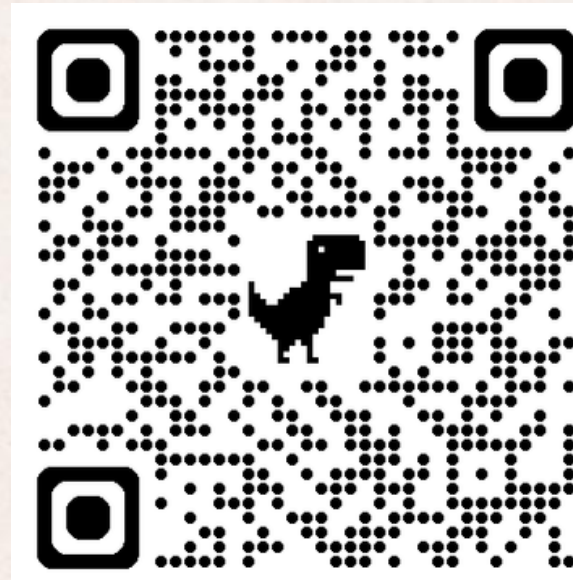

Showbie



Children will use Showbie in class and at home to access resources and share learning. QR codes for logging in at home have been issued in homework folders along with guidance.

Portfolios

Staff/pupils will share one piece of work a fortnight to children's portfolios. Portfolios can be viewed on pupil or parent accounts.

Magma Maths



Magma Maths is new to Glasgow and we will be using it in class and at home. QR codes have been issued in homework folders along with guidance for logging in.

Magma is very user friendly; questions can be translated into many different languages.

It is important to note that for most questions children must show their working before it will allow them to input their answer. This encourages visible thinking.

Homework

P7 Homework

Spelling

1. Find out the definition (meaning) of any words you do not know.
2. Using your assigned spelling activity; complete all your spelling words at least **ONCE** over (more if you want to!)
3. Create 5 sentences using your spelling words. Each sentence should include:
 - a connective (e.g. **and**, **but**, **because** etc)
 - an adjective (e.g. **little** boy, **red** pencil, **wooden** door etc)
 - an exciting verb (e.g. run = **sprint**, walk = **stroll**, eat = **chomp** etc)

Reading

1. Read the assigned pages of your book (ideally aloud to an adult, at home). This can be done with the hardcopy book OR online (www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login)
2. Complete reading task into your jotter.
3. Get a parent/carer to sign your reading bookmark (and leave any comments, if they wish).

Maths

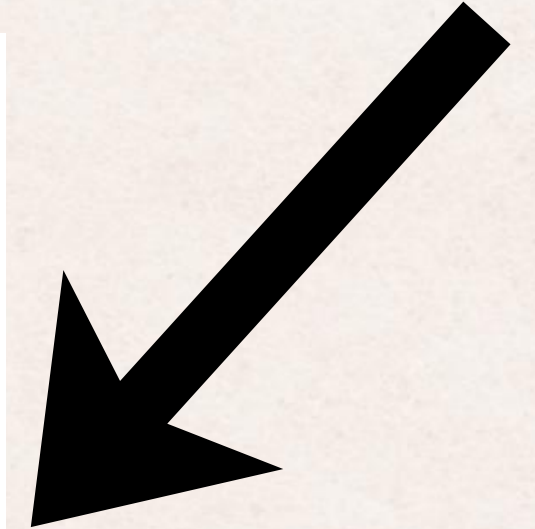

No jewellery (or must be able to take off themselves). GCC policy. Religious jewellery included.

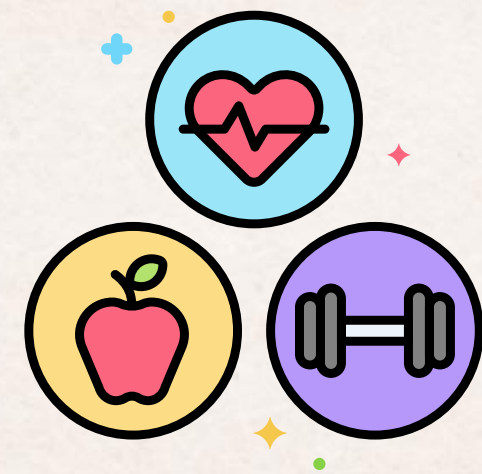
Water bottle

- We are a nut-free school (that includes Nutella, Pestos)

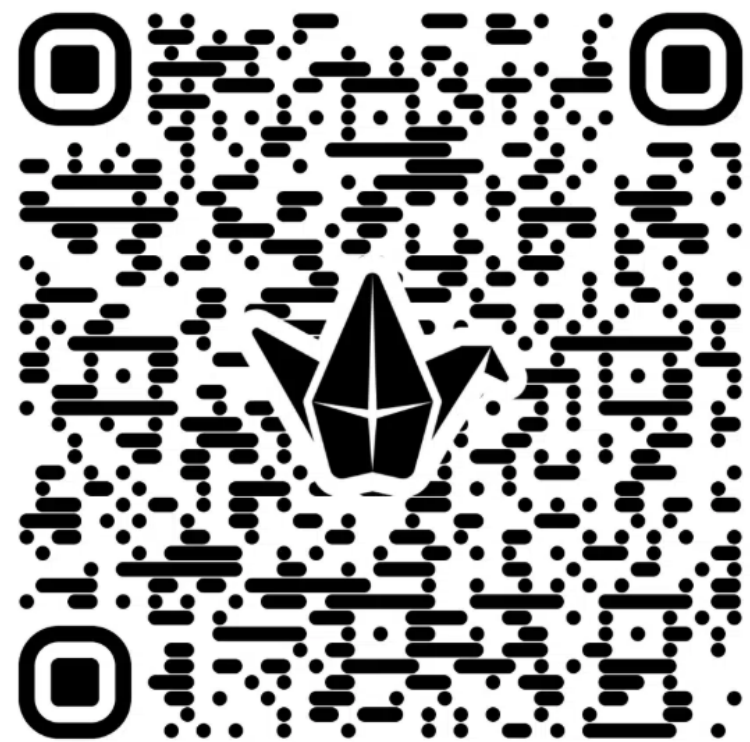


Blairvadach (April 26th- 30th 2027)
