



Literacy and English

Reading – We are focussing on the reading skills of predicting and reading for information.

Talking and Listening – Developing vocabulary and responding to instructions. Working in groups to uplevel sentences creating and working together on discussion tasks.

Writing – Learning to write character descriptions based on description, actions, and speech.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy- In place value working with whole numbers up to 5-digits and beyond, revising and extending addition and subtraction skills along with solving 2 step word problems.

Mathematics -Learning to read and write 12 and 24 hour time and using timetables to calculate time intervals. Looking at regular and irregular 2D shape as well as naming, identifying and classifying them.
