Miss MacDonald will teach **P1a** all day on a **Tuesday** and on a **Wednesday** morning.

Across the year she will cover the following curricular areas: Maths, Expressive Arts (Music, Art, Drama & Dance), Science, RME and French.

Please see below for overview of Learning and Teaching Blocks

Term 1 (August to October)

Maths: we will be learning about: Repeating patterns, 2D shapes and the days of the week.

Music – we will be learning about music beats and rhythm, and we will explore different styles of music. Every alternate Wednesday we will work with Mrs Stevenson, the Youth Music Initiative Teacher.

Art – we will be exploring lines and colour within art.

Science – we will be investigating different types of energy.

RME: we will be exploring: The Christian festival of Harvest.

Term 2 (October to December)

Maths: we will be learning about: information handling, using tally marks and picture graphs. We will also learn how to communicate and navigate using about positional language.

Drama: we will be focusing on: Communicating ideas and feelings through expression. We will also take on a dramatic role through our Christmas performance.

Music – we will be learning about different tempo's and how to sing as a group. Every alternate Wednesday we will work with Mrs Stevenson, the Youth Music Initiative Teacher.

RME: we will be exploring: Welcoming a baby through Christianity, Islam and Judaism. We will also learn about the Christian Christmas Story.

Science – we will be investigating living and non-living things.

Term 3 (January to March)

Maths – we will be learning about: time (daily sequence and O'clock), elements of measure and money (coins up to £2).

Music – we will continue to learn about music styles, beats and rhythm. Every alternate Wednesdays we will work with Mrs Stevenson, the Youth Music Initiative Teacher.

Art – we will be exploring the work of famous artists and creating similar styles of artwork using a variety of materials.

Science – we will be investigating different types of forces.

RME – we will explore the Story of Ruth through Judaism and the Christian story of Easter.

French – we will be learning numbers 1-10 and colours in French.
