Literacy and English

Writing - Children will learn to write to persuade and share their views about how we can make our school better. We will make links with reading and choose well-loved characters to write about; this will include our favourite heroes and villains.

Reading -pupils will study fiction and non-fiction. This will include looking at life in the Victorian times and investigating what happened to the dinosaurs!

Listening & Talking - creating a presentation all about themselves and their likes/dislikes. Children will learn about the importance of being a good audience too.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Additions and subtraction-We will focus on adding 3 numbers together and working with subtraction calculations that involve zero. Some pupils will start to learn about algorithms involving 4-digit numbers.

Multiplication-Children will continue to learn timetables through counting in different ways and some pupils will focus on learning the 4 and 6 timetables

Time-we will look at using calendars in a real-life context. Pupils will revise using an analogue clock and we will look again at 5-minute intervals for some groups.

Money-children will start to look at money problems beyond £1, and some pupils will start to make links with decimals and place value to calculate totals and change.

Interdisciplinary Learning

P4/3 's topic is the difference between living and non-living things. Pupils will choose living creatures to focus on; learning about food chains, habitats and life cycles. We will also focus on classification; using different methods to sort the world around us into categories.
