Literacy and English

- Read/Spell 300-500 Common Words and continue with the RWI Spelling programme.
- Listening and Talking - Group talk will be the focus this term as the children will be creating a presentation all about a scandinavian country, linking in with their social studies topic, Vikings.
- Writing - creating a procedural text and write a character description. This will allow the children to practise putting steps in logical order as well as describing the appearance and actions of a specific character.

- Round decimal fractions to the nearest whole number.
- Add and subtract decimal fractions.
- Solve word problems using the four operations.
