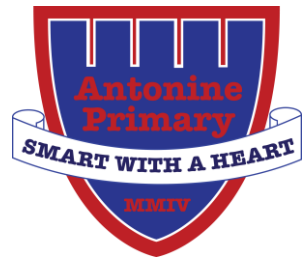
Literacy and English
