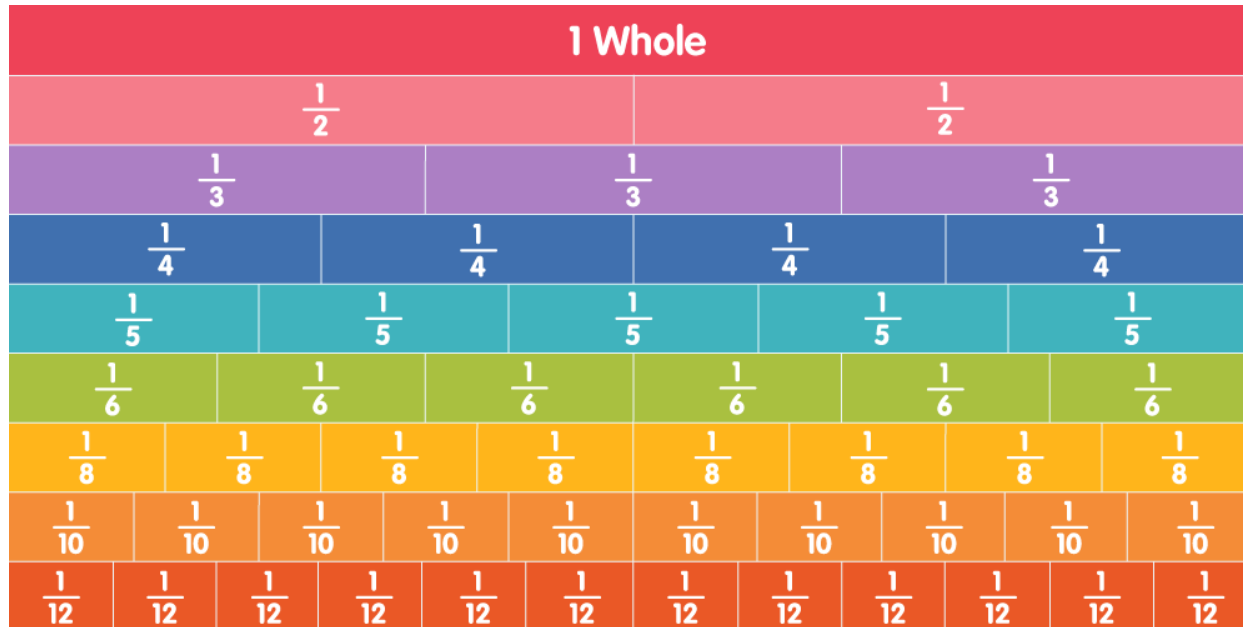

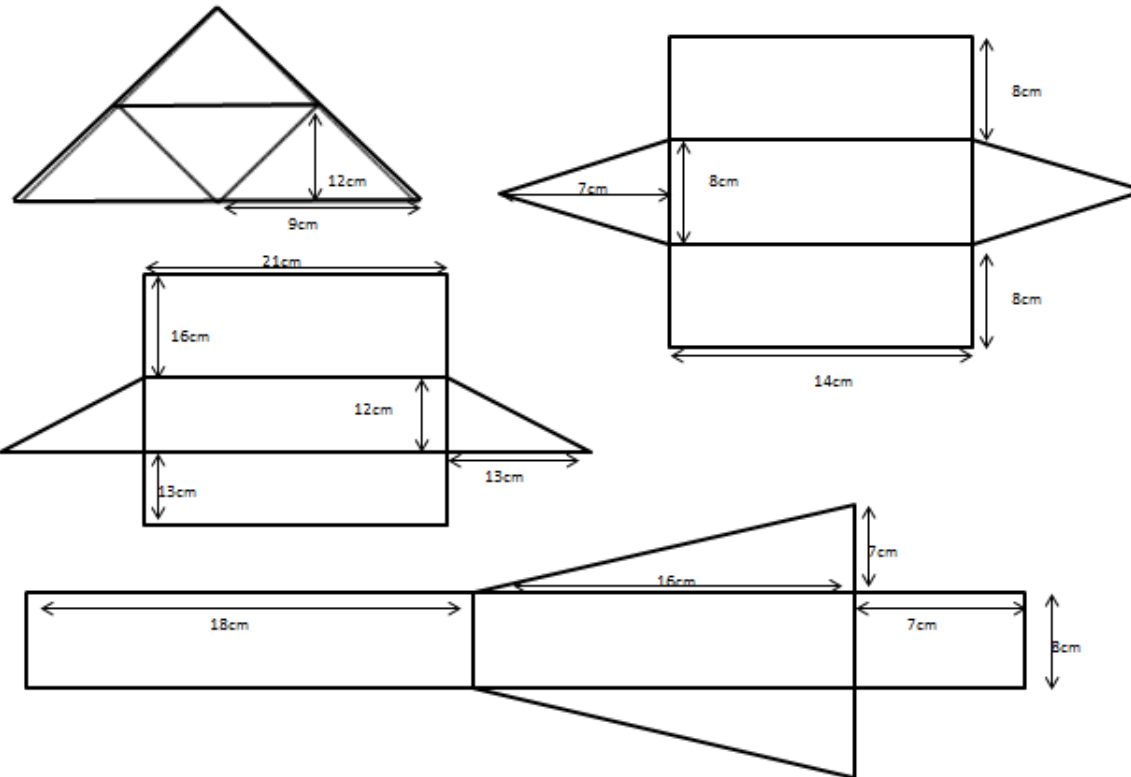
You could use paper to draw out a fraction wall.

Use sections of paper...



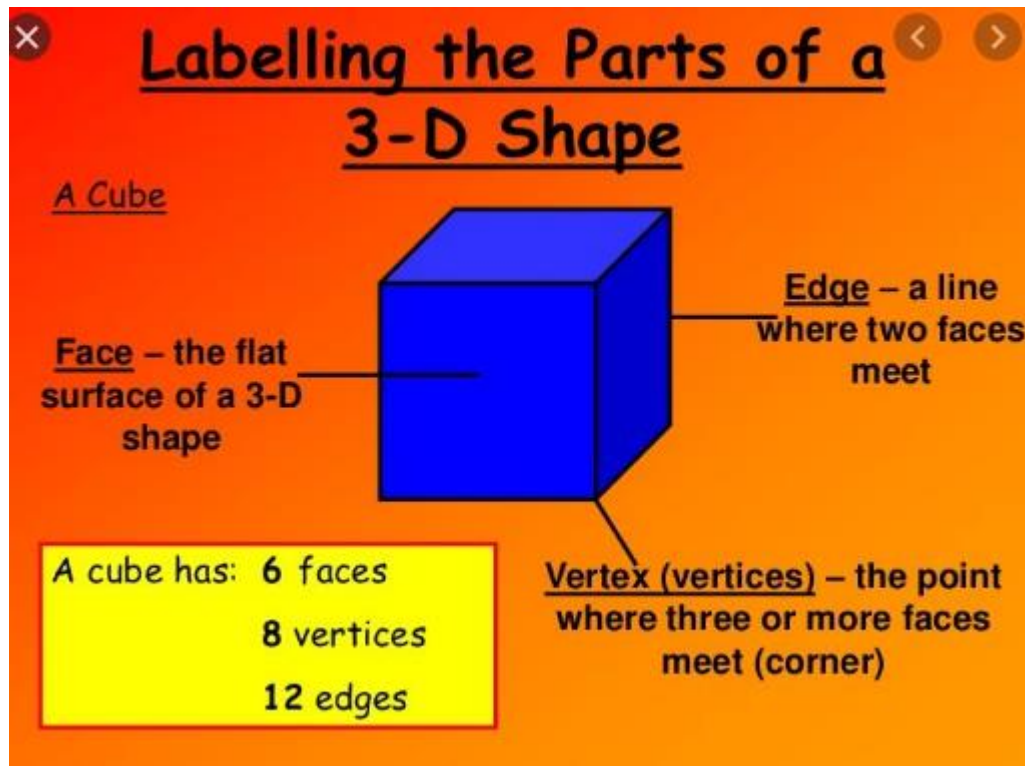
Use the measurements provided to find out the surface area of these nets. They are not drawn to scale, so don't try to measure them!
