<p>DEAR</p> <p>“Drop Everything and Read” Try to find time in the day just to relax and have some enjoyable reading time!</p>	<p>Percy the Park Keeper is always busy. <u>Write 1, 2 or 3 sentences about the chores Percy has to do in the park.</u> Remember to start with a capital letter, use connectives (and, then, because, so, but) and end each sentence with a full stop.</p>	<p><u>Animal syllables</u> Play with a family member. Take turns to name different animals. One point each time to whoever said the animal with the most syllables. Want to play again? Just change the theme eg sports, food etc</p>
<p><u>Phonics.</u> (choose your stage) Stage 2: Phoneme : “au” as in Laura Word list: August, Paul, Laura, because, applaud Stage 1: Phoneme: “qu” as in quick Word list: quick, queen, quit, quilt Read the words, write the words and highlight the phoneme, add more words to the list, write 1, 2 or 3 sentences using the words.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u> (choose your stage) Stage 2: week, keep, when, because Stage 1: him, his, did Spell each word out loud. Speed writing: write each word as many times as you can in 30seconds. Challenge a family member to do the same! Spell each word out loud again (no peeking at the word!)</p>	<p><u>Adjectives (describing words)</u> Design a new outfit for the warm summer weather. Draw the outfit and use adjectives to describe its colours and style.</p>
<p>“ I See, I Think, I Wonder”: Choose any picture from a book/newspaper/magazine, tell a family about the picture:  I can see..... I think..... I wonder if..... </p>	<p><u>Summer Verbs (action words)</u> Write a list of things you would <u>do</u> at the beach eg, paddling, sunbathing Draw a beach picture to go with your verbs.</p>	<p><u>What’s Missing?</u> Choose upto 10 small objects (eg pen, coin, button etc) Spread them out on a tray or table, ask a family member to look and memorise what they see. Ask the family member to look away and you remove 1 or 2 objects, can your family member say what is missing?</p>
