Following the announcement by the First Minister on Tuesday 16th February, I can now confirm that all P1-3 children will be returning to school on Monday 22nd of February. This return to school does not include Primary 4-7 children who will continue with Remote Learning, this will be reviewed by Scottish Government in a few weeks. No date for the return of P4-7 children has been confirmed.
