Literacy

Writing –we will be developing our use of Capital Letters and full stops in the correct place, and learning about how to recount our own experiences.

Reading – we will be increasing our fluency and accuracy using our phonics amongst other strategies to decode new words.

- Explore calendars, months of the year, dates and different ways of writing the date
- Investigate numbers in our environment and how numbers are involved in our day to day lives

Creative

This term we will be developing our colour mixing skills our own emotional responses to colour as we learn about Mark Rothko's Colour Field work.

We will investigate different materials to make a 3d shape in response to the sculptor, Alberto Giacometti
