

Primary P3/2 Class Newsletter Term 1

Literacy:

Reading: Revision of Literacy Circles, focussing on prediction and developing comprehension skills.

Writing: Recount & character descriptions. P2 will be looking at how to structure our work and use of capital letters and full stops. P3 will be developing their use of connectives and punctuation.

Talking and Listening: Within literacy circles, we will look at what 'good' talking and listening looks and sounds like with a focus on listening to each other and following instructions.

Spelling: Beginning with revision of our phonics and spelling rules from P1 and P2, we will develop our knowledge of spelling strategies and sounds.

Maths and Numeracy: Time: Basic elements of time, using a calendar and timetable.

Number & Number processes: Investigate whole numbers and place value, skip counting.

Shape: Properties of 2D shapes & 3D objects.

Patterns & relationships: Recognise and continue number and shape patterns.

Health and Wellbeing: Looking at our school's nurture principles and the school values. We will revise our Emotion works cogs and spend time building relationships in our classroom.

P.E: fitness and building social skills through games and team challenges.

Social Studies: We have already started a mini topic on the Lighthouse Keeper's lunch. We have had some design challenges looking at how lighthouses are built. We have been learning about balanced diets and sea birds.
